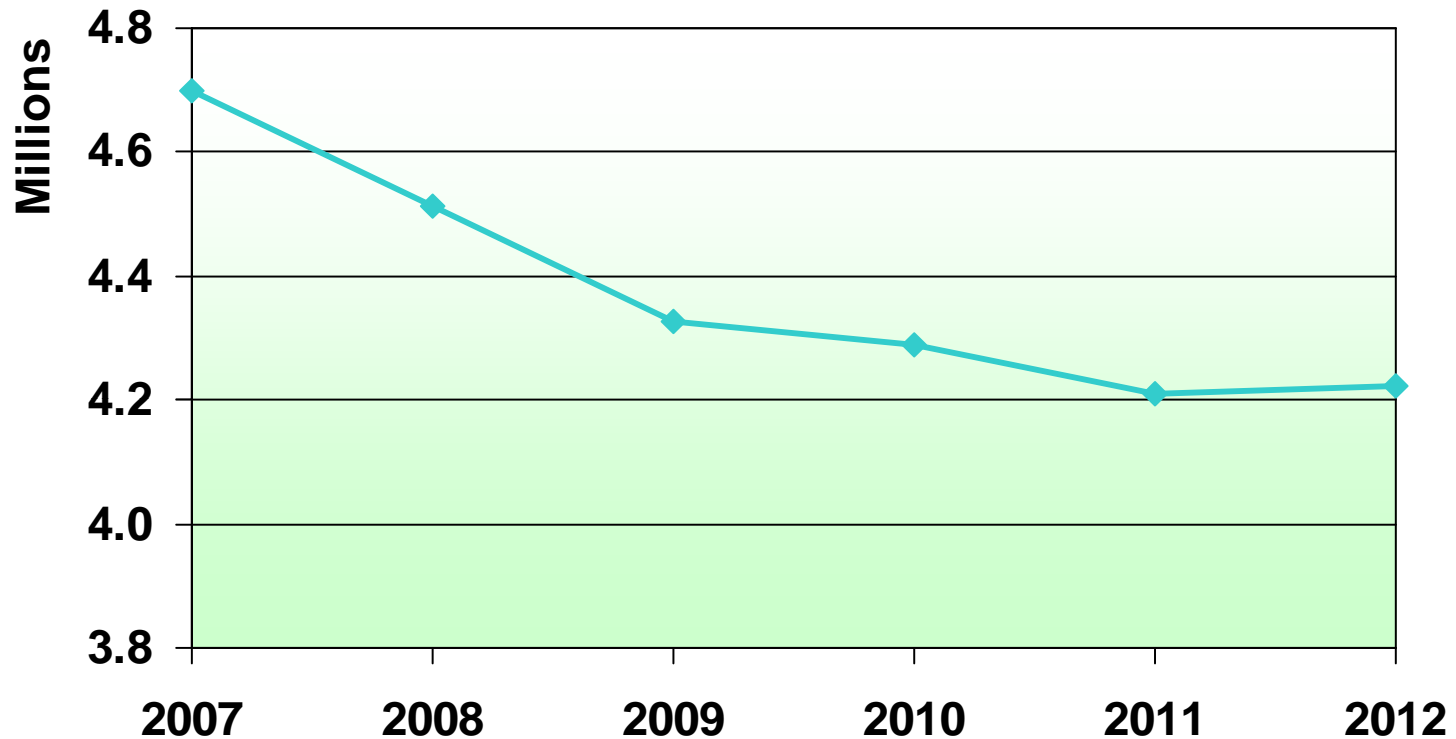


Rhode Island Gas Tax Revenue Per Penny of Tax



The chart above shows how much money the State receives for each penny of the 33 cent per gallon gas tax.

With citizens driving less and cars becoming more fuel efficient, the State, and RIDOT, receives less revenue from the gas tax. In 2007, the State received \$ 4.7 million for each penny of gas tax. Now the State is receiving only about \$ 4.2 million for each penny. A loss to the State of about \$16 million.
